Purpose Of Report

For Members to consider evidence produced at a public hearing taking into account the details contained within this report and any representations made at this meeting for an application to grant a New Premises Licence to Selston FC (Selston Sports Association) in relation to Selston Parish Cricket Pavillion, Sports Ground, Mansfield Road, Selston, Nottinghamshire, NG16 6EE; and to determine the application by taking such of the steps set out below as the Committee considers necessary for the promotion of the licensing objectives.

Recommendation(s)

Members having regard to the application and any relevant representations, take such of the following steps as they consider appropriate for the promotion of the licensing objectives:

The Sub-Committee must take such of the following steps as it considers appropriate for the promotion of the licensing objectives:

- a) Grant the licence in accordance with the application.
- b) Modify the conditions of the operating schedule by altering or omitting or adding to them.
- Exclude or restrict from the scope of the licence any of the licensable activities to which the application relates.
- d) Reject the whole of the application.

The Sub-Committee may also grant the licence subject to different conditions for different parts of the premises or the different licensable activities.

Reasons for Recommendation(s)

Members must consider all evidence offered at the Hearing and make an unbiased decision on the evidence offered. In making any decision, Members must also have regard to the Home Office statutory guidance issued under section 182 of the Licensing Act 2003 (which can be found online at):

Detailed Information

The Licensing Act 2003 came in to force in September 2005. It passed the powers to the Local Authority to licence premises for any of the following licensable activities:

- The sale by retail of alcohol;
- The supply of alcohol by or on behalf of a club or to the order of a member of the club;
- The provision of regulated entertainment; and
- The provision of late night refreshment.

The licensing objectives are:

- The prevention of crime and disorder;
- The promotion of public safety;
- The prevention of public nuisance; and
- The protection of children from harm.

Each objective is of equal importance. There are no other statutory licensing objectives, so that the promotion of the four objectives is a paramount consideration at all times. However, the legislation also supports a number of other key aims and purposes. These are vitally important and should be principal aims for everyone involved in licensing work.

Section 18 of the 2003 Act, allows Interested Persons, and Responsible Authorities, to make representations in favour or against applications for the grant of a Premises Licence. Should representations be made that cannot be resolved between the parties during any consultation period, then the application must be determined by a Licensing Committee or Sub-Committee Hearing.

Other Relevant Considerations

The Sub-Committee is reminded of its responsibilities under the Crime and Disorder Act 1998 (to co-operate in the reduction of crime and disorder in the Ashfield District) and the Human Rights Act (which guarantees the right to a fair hearing for all parties in the determination of their civil rights, and also provides for the protection of property, which may include licences in existence, and the protection of private and family life) when considering the fair balance between the interests of the all parties to thisplagating.

Any decision taken by the Sub-Committee must be necessary and proportionate to the objectives being pursued.

Members are reminded that whenever they make a decision under the Licensing Act 2003, they have a duty to act with a view to promoting the licensing objectives.

When considering any representations, only those issues relating to the licensing objectives should be considered, and appropriate weight given to the importance and relevance of each representation.

Members should note that the applicant or persons making representations have the right of appeal against the decision made by the Sub-Committee.

Summary of Application

On 16th February 2018, the Licensing Authority received an application from Selston FC (Selston Sports Association) for the grant of a New Premises Licence for Selston Parish Cricket Pavillion, Sports Ground, Mansfield Road, Selston, Nottinghamshire, NG16 6EE, seeking to provide licensable activities from the Cricket Pavillion.

A summary of the licensable activities applied for and the times proposed for these activities can be found detailed below.

During the 28 day consultation period, Nottinghamshire Police agreed specific conditions with the applicant. A copy of these conditions and the applicants' agreement to adopt them is attached at **Appendix B**.

During the 28 day consultation period the Licensing Team received one representation submitted by an Interested Party objecting to the application. This representation is attached at **Appendix C**, and the representation raises concerns that the proposed business may undermine the licensing objective of the prevention of public nuisance.

A map detailing the general location of the premises is attached at **Appendix D**.





 - Plays: no licence is required for performances between 08:00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - Films: no licence is required for 'not-for-profit' film exhibition held in community premises between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day provided that the audience does not exceed 500 and the organiser (a) gets consent to the screening from a person who is responsible for the premises; and (b) ensures that each such screening abides by age classification ratings.
 - Indoor sporting events; no licence is required for performances between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 1000.
 - Boxing or Wrestling Entertainment: no licence is required for a contest, exhibition or display of Greco-Roman wrestling, or freestyle wrestling between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 1000. Combined fighting sports – defined as a contest, exhibition or display which combines boxing or wrestling with one or more martial arts - are licensable as a boxing or wrestling entertainment rather than an indoor sporting event.
 - Live music: no licence permission is required for:
 - o a performance of unamplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, on any premises.

Nottinghamshire Police have received an application for a new premises licence for Selston Cricket Pavillion, Sports Ground, Mansfield Road, Selston.

After liaising with Inspector Longden, I would like to propose the following conditions which would be placed upon the premises licence. These conditions are not too dissimilar from the information you supplied within the operating schedule upon the licence application. If you are in agreement with these conditions and variation to times, please reply before the end of today and state your agreement, I will then notify the licensing authority. If you disagree please state this in an email and I will submit a notice of representation.

- 1. A CCTV system with recording equipment shall be recorded on the plan appended to the licence. The system shall be installed prior to the premises carrying out licensable activities and maintained in full working order. Recordings to be made available for inspection when requested by the Police or any other authorised person.
 - All recordings used in conjunction with CCTV shall:
- be of evidential quality
- indicate the time and date
- be retained for a period of 31 days
- Sufficient members of staff trained to use the system to be able to view playback and record footage.
- 2. A incident book or electronic record shall be kept to record all instances of crime, disorder, and damage to the property. This book shall be made available for inspection and copying by the Police or any other authorised

person upon request and all such books shall be retained at the premises for at least 12 months.

- 3. All members of staff shall be fully trained in the retail sale of alcohol. The training shall be on-going and each member of staff shall be reviewed every six months. All details of the level of training shall be recorded in book or electronic record. This information shall be made available for inspection and copying by the Police or any other authorised person on request and all such books shall be retained at the premises for at least 12 months.
- 4. A Challenge 25 scheme shall operate at the premises. Any person who appears to be under 25 years of age shall not be allowed to purchase alcohol unless they produce an acceptable form of photo identification. (e.g. passport, driving licence, Military ID or PASS accredited card).
- 5. Challenge 25 notices shall be displayed in prominent positions throughout the premises.
- 6. There shall not be any adult entertainment or services, activities, other entertainment or matters ancillary to the use of the premises that may give rise to concern in respect of children.
- 7. Customers shall not be allowed to remove open vessels from the premises.
