Explanatory Note

1. The Council is required by the above Regulations to give 28 clear days' notice of key or exempt decisions. The Forward Plan includes a schedule of all Key and Exempt Decisions which are likely to be taken in the next four months. Where a Key Decision needs to be made on a matter which has not been included on the Forward Plan, the above Regulations provide for a case of Special Urgency to enable the decision to be made.

2. The Special Urgency provision requires that if it is impracticable to give 28 clear days' notice, the public are informed that the decision has been made following agreement by the Chairman of the Overview and Scrutiny Committee. The Leader is required to submit a report to the next available Council meeting advising of any decision(s) taken as cases of Special Urgency.
