b) The prevention of crime and disorder

A CCTV system with recording equipment shall be installed and maintained at the premises and operated with cameras. All recordings used in conjunction with CCTV shall:-

- Be of evidential quality.
- Indicate the correct time and date.
- Be retained for a period of 31 consecutive days.

Images shall be made available for inspection by the police or relevant officer of the licensing authority at all reasonable times. All images downloaded from the CCTV system must be provided in a format that can be viewed on readily available equipment without the need for specialist software.

A proof of age policy will operate in relation to relevant licensable activities.

Drinking outside the premises by customers shall not be allowed after 23:00 hours on any day.

c) Public safety

The premises will operate in accordance with all relevant legislation which promotes the public safety objective including, but not limited to, the Health & Safety At Work etc Act 1974 and associated regulations, the Food Safety Act 1990, the Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2005 and the Disability discrimination Act 1975.

Clear notices shall be prominently displayed requesting customers to leave the premises and the area in a quiet and orderly manner.

The necessary fire safety precautions will be installed and maintained.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

The premises will operate in accordance with all relevant legislation which promotes the public nuisance objective including but not limited to the Environmental Protection Act 1990 and the Noise Act 1996.

Clear notices shall be prominently displayed requesting customers to leave the premises and the area in a quiet and orderly manner.

The premises will be adequately ventilated to prevent nuisance.

Arrangements will be made for the storage and disposal of refuse which do not cause a nuisance.

Any noise from the licensable activities provided will be monitored in order to prevent nuisance.

Doors shall be kept closed during amplified musical regulated entertainment except for access and egress and in the event of an emergency.
